Students will be graded on their ability to handle the vehicle in different situations and how they perform on the Road Test.

Cooperative Driver Testing Program

Each Student who successfully completes the driver education course of classroom and behind-the-wheel instruction with a grade of A or B may not be required to take a road test at the time they apply for their driver's license. Our school is part of this testing program and each student will be required to pass a road test that I will administer. They may also have to take the road test at the driver service facility, due to the Secretary of State's Office establishing a procedure for spot checking student's road test and applications. Under the spot check, students whose birthdays fall on certain dates will be required to pass a road test administered at the driver service facility. Therefore, each student must be prepared to take the road test when they go to the driver service facility to apply for their license.
